

**TOWN OF MAGRATH
BYLAW # 1267
(Public Notification Bylaw)**

Being a bylaw of the Town of Magrath
to provide for alternative methods of public notification of items required to be
advertised under the *Municipal Government Act*.

WHEREAS under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, Chapter M-26, and amendments thereto (the Act), the Council of the Town of Magrath must advertise certain bylaws, resolutions, meetings and public hearings;

WHEREAS under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Act, Council may pass a bylaw respecting alternative methods of advertising certain bylaws, resolutions, meetings and public hearings other than those methods set out in the Act; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Magrath wishes to pass a bylaw to provide for alternative advertising requirements for those bylaws, resolutions, meetings and public hearings required to be advertised under the Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Magrath in Council duly assembled enacts as follows:

1.1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "Public Notification Bylaw".

INTERPRETATION

2.1 In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires, Town means the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Magrath.

ALTERNATIVE METHODS OF ADVERTISING

3.1 Those bylaws, resolutions, meetings and public hearings that are required to be advertised under the Act will be advertised as follows:

- a) by publishing the title and a statement of the general purpose in at least one (1) newspaper or publication circulating in the area to which the proposed bylaw, resolution or other thing relates, or in which the meeting or hearing is to be held;
- b) by referring interested parties to the Town's website <http://www.magrath.ca> for more comprehensive details of the bylaw, resolution, meeting or public hearing as required in the Act;


- c) by publishing the complete notification of the proposed bylaw, resolution or other thing to which the proposed bylaw or other thing relates for which the meeting or hearing is to be held on the Town's website for thirteen (13) days prior to that event; and
- d) by having hardcopies available at Town Hall for viewing by the public during regular office hours.

4.1 This bylaw comes into force on the day it is passed.

Read for a third time and passed this 11th day of August, 2020.
