

BY-LAW #981

A By-Law of the Town of Magrath for the prevention of fires and the protection of persons from injury or destruction by fire.

WHEREAS

Section 158(a) authorizes a Council to pass fire prevention and personal protection by-laws and

WHEREAS

Council has deemed it necessary to ban the sale and firing of fireworks and firecrackers within the Town of Magrath except by special permit issued by the Fire Chief of the Town of Magrath.

NOW THEREFORE

The Council of the Town of Magrath in the Province of Alberta duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. No person, persons, or organizations shall sell, offer to sell or set off any fireworks or firecrackers within the Town of Magrath unless they are in possession of a special permit issued by the Fire Chief of the Town of Magrath.
2. Any person guilty of any infraction or breach of any of the provisions of this By-Law shall upon summary conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding \$500 exclusive of costs.

This By-Law will go into effect at the final reading thereof.

Read a first time this 23rd Day of June 1987.

Read a second time this 14th Day of July 1987.

Read a third and final time and passed this 14th day of July 1987.
